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Conflict of Interest Disclosure Form

Definitions

The term “investigator” means the principal investigator, co-principal investigators, and any other person at the institution who is responsible for the design, conduct, or reporting of research or educational activities funded or proposed for funding.

The term “significant financial interest” means anything of monetary value, including but not limited to, salary or other payments for services (e.g., consulting fees or honoraria); equity interest (e.g., stocks, stock options, or other ownership interests); and intellectual property rights (e.g., patents, copyrights, and royalties from such rights).

The term does not include:

- salary, royalties, or other remuneration from Lafayette College;
- income from seminars, lectures, or teaching engagements sponsored by public or non-profit entities;
- income from service on advisory committees or review panels for public record or nonprofit entities;
- an equity interest that, when aggregated for the investigator and the investigator’s immediate family, meets both of the following tests: does not exceed \$10,000 in value as determined through references to public prices or other reasonable measures of fair market value, and does not represent more than a 5% ownership interest in any single entity; or
- salary, royalties, or other payments that, when aggregated for the investigator and his/her immediate family, are not expected to exceed \$10,000 during the twelve month period.
